Louis Sullivan appeared before the board and requested the Cemetery Road be plowed just a little further, as he has a relative living there full time. Kevin stated he will look into it and request it be plowed past the full time residence.

Mary Sears appeared before the board and asked about the Coal Dock and Pontiac Road. Kevin stated the Houghton County Road Commission got the final approval on a grant for 2019 for the improvement of the Coal Dock Road, and will figure an estimate on the Pontiac Road for the expenditure of approximately \$200,000.00, which the township would like to spend. Kevin will also get her a copy of the Houghton County Road Commission five (5) year plan.
